### Cell Phone

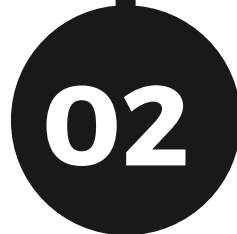
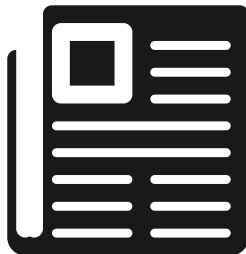
Cell phones are great writing tools because they can be used to take photos and record content ideas with a note taking app.
